- Avoid using a dirty or wet mop
- Use a dry mop when possible for general cleaning

Tips for caring for your new floors:

- Use area and throw rugs in high traffic areas
- Use felt coasters under furniture legs
- Sweep and dust regularly to remove abrasives that can cause scratching
- Wipe up spills immediately so moisture doesn't seep into floor boards
- Do not drag furniture or appliances- these should be picked up and placed back down
- Avoid wearing high heels on bare floors
